FEAR

Twelve disciples of Jesus Were Peter, Andrew, James, John Philip, Bartholmew, Thomas, Matthew, James Thaddaeus, Simon the zealot Judas Iscariot all found themselves in a terrible storm and the little boat they were in was being tossed about by the winds and waves. Water began filling the ship and it looked as if they were on the verge of sinking. FEAR and panic filled the hearts of the disciples and when they approached the Lord, His question to them was, "Why are ye so fearful?" Mark 4:40. Hundreds of years earlier, the psalmist had asked himself a similar question: "Whom shall I fear," and of whom shall I be afraid"?... Let us remember that the apostle Peter is giving instruction to these recipients as to how to live as exiles and sojourners both socially and spiritually.



What does the Bible Tell us about Fear?
