QUESTION

Why did God let this happen?

Does God Care? Are You Sure God Exists?

Whether you're a believer in God or not at some point in our lives.

When <u>bad things</u> happen to us, it's easy to think that God doesn't care about you, or that He isn't involved in the world today. It's easy to think of God sometimes as your uncaring boss at work. You know the kind that sits down in his office with his feet up on his desk, clipping his nails?
