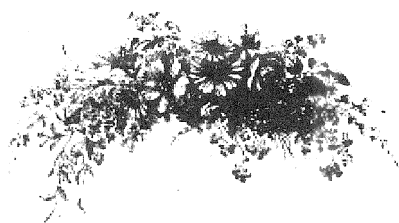
— The Obituary —
